KS1 Panto in School KS1 will have a panto in school at 9.30am on Monday, 11th December.

KS2 Panto at the Rhodes Centre

On Monday, 11th December, KS2 will be walking to the Rhodes Centre in the morning for their panto. Please ensure your child comes into school in suitable outdoor clothing. We will be back in time for lunch at school. Due to returning after the school lunch break, those children who normally have a school meal will be provided with a school packed lunch.

Year 5/6 **Choir** Carol Service at St Michael's Church at 7.00pm Year 5 and 6 school choir members will be taking part in the Bishop's Stortford Primary Schools' Carol Service at St Michael's Church at **7.00pm**.
