# **Free School Meals**

Children in years 3 and above have to pay for school dinners.

Please see below in case you qualify for free school meals

Did you know that Hertfordshire County Council could save you £400 every year? If you receive one of the following benefits, you could be eligible for free school meals worth over £450 per child per year:

- Income Support
- Income-based jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (as long as you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and you do not get more that £16,190 a year)
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit
