## **Attendance Procedures**

Attendance/sickness absence: If your child is off school, please ring and leave a message on the first day of absence BEFORE 9.30am. Please state your child's name, class, and reason for absence.

Please state a clear reason i.e. cold, sickness. Please do not just say 'unwell.'

Due to a change in attendance procedures, the school is will telephone parents on the first day of absence if we have not received notification by 9.30am.

If your child has had diarrhoea, then they should be clear for 48 hours from the last episode, before returning to school.

**Punctuality:** The gates open at 8.45am each day (10 minutes early) to allow for a flow of parents/carers to drop off their children. Children arriving after 8.55am will need to be signed in by their parent/carer giving a valid reason for the lateness, as opposed to just putting 'late'. We are required by law to have this in place and to request this.
