# **Headteacher's News**

I am delighted to announce that this week the Nursery and Reception gained the National Early Years Quality Mark. It looked in detail at the quality of the provision and the feedback given was that it was 'exceptional'. The staff have worked extremely hard over recent months to enhance the quality of teaching and learning, with the outdoor environment particularly improved to really develop high quality learning experiences. Thank you to Mrs Boom who has led the project. Feedback said that the children were all highly engaged and successful learners. Thank you also to the parents who gave up their time to talk to the assessor and to all the staff who have worked extremely hard, particularly Miss Clark and Mrs Aziz.

Well done to Jenny and the kitchen staff who were awarded five stars (the highest mark possible) in their Environmental Health Check this week.

#### **Whole School Evacuation**

Don't forget the whole school evacuation next, **Monday, 25th June** to the site of the Rugby Club to practice what would happen if there was a serious incident at school and we had to evacuate the site. This is the first time we have done this so please be patient. Can parents please pick up their children from the **Rugby Club** at the end of the school day. <u>All teachers</u> will need to hand over children to adults as we would in a real event. We will wait until **all** the children are at the Rugby Club before dismissing them. The children will be bringing their belongings with them ready to go straight home. Children who will be attending Night Owls or after school clubs on that day will be walked back to school by staff, so parents of these children need not come to the Rugby Club.
