Please ensure you do not send your child into school with any symptoms, and take them for a PCR test if a member of the family tests positive. Covid-19 Isolation Guidance

We would kindly ask you to keep our school community safe by strictly following the guidelines. Please do not send children into school if any of the following apply:

- they have any one of the symptoms of Covid-19. Symptoms suggestive of Covid-19 are a <u>new</u> continuous cough, high temperature or a loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell.
- they, any members of your household, or any close contacts (including family, friends or work colleagues they have seen, sports clubs, etc.) who are being tested for, or have tested positive for COVID-19, even where they are not showing symptoms.

If you live in the same household as someone with Covid-19 stay at home and self-isolate.

Your isolation period includes the day the first person in your household's <u>symptoms</u> started (or the day their test was taken if they did not have symptoms) and the next 10 full days. This means that if, for example, your 10 day isolation period starts on the 15th of the month, your isolation period ends at 23:59 hrs on the 25th and you can return to your normal routine.

If you are identified as a contact and asked to self-isolate you may be entitled to a payment of £500 under the <u>Test</u> <u>and Trace Support Payment scheme</u>. If you are the parent or guardian of a child who has been told to self-isolate you may also be entitled to this payment.

Failure to comply with self-isolation may result in a fine, starting from £1,000. Parents or guardians are legally responsible for ensuring that anyone under 18 self-isolates if they test positive for COVID-19 and are contacted by NHS Test and Trace and told to self-isolate.
