We talked about the importance of discussing new vocabulary when your child is reading. If your child is in KS2, please encourage them to write any words that you have discussed at the bottom of the page in their reading record. Even if your child is a fluent reader, please still discuss the vocabulary and the story with them to support their reading skills. If you would like ideas for recommended books please look on the website under Our learning / English / Reading. Audio books are also a great way to be exposed to a wide vocabulary if your child is a reluctant reader.

Next week is **eSafety Week** at school when the focus of assemblies and Computing lessons will be looking at keeping our children safe on the internet. The PTA are kindly supporting this event by funding Coram Education to come and lead sessions for the KS2 children. Please note there is a session for parents of Upper Key Stage 2 next Wednesday, 28th November at 2.20pm before the work sharing. We look forward to seeing you.
