# **Headteacher's News**

The staff have been busy getting ready for having the children back in school on Monday. Everyone is very excited! I would like to thank all the staff who have worked extremely hard, teaching in new ways during this lockdown. Support staff have also done a fantastic job in the key worker classes. Ofsted are asking for parents' opinions on home learning so if you are interested in expressing your views to them, please go to Ofsted parent view.

We are now looking forward to a safe return. Our teachers, support staff, club leaders and specialist visitors will now be required to take lateral flow tests before coming into school, in order to identify asymptomatic cases.

We currently have 2 members of staff isolating, so it is important to stress that Coronavirus is still in our community. As ever, we want to try and keep all our bubbles open so please make sure that you continue to follow Government guidance.

In addition to staff testing, the Government has confirmed that Lateral Flow Tests will now be given free to all families and households with primary and secondary aged children. This quick test could screen all family members that you feel are old enough to be tested without trauma. By doing this, it will help with the identification of asymptomatic cases, which will help to keep your children, other families and our whole school community safe.

Primary schools do not have testing kits for our families. You can get your testing kits through your employer, if they are offering testing, through a local test site, by collecting a home testing kit from a <u>local test kit collection point</u>, or by ordering <u>Lateral Flow</u> Test kits online.

These tests should be taken twice weekly (3 or 4 days apart) and test results should be reported to NHS Test and Trace within 24 hours of taking the test. You can report your test online or by calling 119.

If anyone in your household tests positive or gets Coronavirus symptoms, they must tell inform the school immediately by emailing absence@northgate.herts.sch.uk or by calling the school office on 01279 652376. In the case of a positive lateral flow test result you must:

- self-isolate immediately
- get a PCR test to confirm the result
- follow the stay at home guidance for households with possible Coronavirus infection

Please keep following the current advice including:

- regular handwashing
- social distancing
- wearing a face covering where recommended.

# Safeguarding

#### **Parking**

For the safety of all our children, please could we ask that you use the Rugby Club car park where possible, and to avoid mass parking on Cricketfield Lane and Grailands. Please also note that the Cricket Club car park is still closed and therefore no parking will be available in their car park. Please do not park on the pavement at any time.

### **Car Fumes**

In order to reduce the level of toxic fumes, both around our school and the homes of our neighbours, please ensure that car engines are turned off when stationary. We regularly receive letters from local residents who are concerned at the high levels of car fumes, dangerous parking on pavements and double parking in and around the bays outside school. Clearly we do not want there to be an accident involving a child so please ensure that you park safely at all times when outside school.

#### **Aspects Workshops**

Aspects are holding two workshops for parents and carers of children aged 5-11 during March. Parenting a Child with Anxiety is an interactive light bite masterclass delivered to you via Zoom. This workshop allows you to understand anxiety and think about how to support a child with anxiety. Don't Shout at Me! - 5 steps to a calmer family life is an interactive workshop which allows you to explore the best ways of approaching angry behaviour and develop a calmer family environment. #### **Return to School Information**

## **School Lunches**

Ordering school lunches will continue in the same way via School Grid. Payment for lunches will continue to be made on School Gateway. Please ensure your child's account is in credit before booking lunches for the remainder of this term. The cost of a lunch is £2.60 per day and current balances can be viewed in School Gateway.

Children who have forgotten their home packed lunch will have a school packed lunch on that day as items cannot be dropped off at the school office. If your child does bring their own packed lunch, please ensure they can open all the packaging themselves and ensure that all items are nut free.

#### Uniform

The children should return to school in full school uniform, details of which can be found on the school website.

We are understanding that your child may have grown out of their school shoes and it is currently difficult to purchase new ones for them. If this is the case, please send your child to school in other suitable shoes until the shops re-open.

Please could we ask you to strictly adhere to the drop off and collection times via your usual gate and remember to socially distance at all times. As a reminder we have shown these times for you here:

#### **Covid-19 Self-Isolating**

Before you return to school, it is vital to remember to follow these important guidelines to protect our staff and pupils in school. Please do not send children into school if any of the following apply:

they have any one of the symptoms of Covid-19, a temperature of over  $37.8^{\circ}$ c, a persistent cough and/or a loss or change to their sense of smell or taste;

they, or any members of your household are isolating, awaiting test results or have tested positive for Covid-19.
