# **Headteacher's News**

The children have been participating in 'Walk to School Week' and talked about the issues around health and wellbeing. The class that had walked the most this week was class 5. Thanks to the everyone who has supported the Walk to School Week. I have had a letter from a concerned pupil, Emily who lives in one of the neighbouring roads, that people are parking inconsiderately in the road she lives in, making it difficult for larger vehicles, such as ambulances and fire engines to get down. I have also had complaints about parents leaving their car engines running outside the school, impacting the air pollution. Please park considerably.
