# **Spring Term 2020**

#### Maths

We will be looking at measurement including height, length, weight and volume. Children will be comparing, describing and solving problems with these measurements. We will then look at money. This will include using coins and combinations to 20p. We will also be ordering and comparing money. Following this we will be learning multiples of 2s, 5s and 10s. Please help your children to learn these times tables. Please also help them practise number bonds to 10.

# **Our Topic**

Our first topic is Bright Lights, Big City. In history we will be finding out about and comparing the lives of Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth II. We will work on creating timelines and comparing transport in the Victorian era to transport today. We will also look at the 2012 London Olympics as an example of a recent historical event in our locality. In science we will explore materials and their properties, including sorting, classifying and testing. We will create food and decorations for our tea party with 'The Queen' In RE we focusing on 'belonging'. We will look at the schools, communities, families and faiths that we might belong long to.

We will then move on to Paws, Claws and Whiskers, which has an animal focus. In science we learn about and compare a variety of different animals. We will look at animal diets and the differences between carnivores, omnivores and herbivores. In Geography we will learn about the continents and oceans of the world, and compare our local area to that of a different country (Uganda). In art will use animals as a starting point for different artistic techniques. such as drawing and collage.
