# Autumn Term 2019

### Welcome to Year 1

We have an exciting term ahead and hopefully this will give you an idea of some of the activities that we have planned for your children.

The team this year are Mrs Shepherd and Mrs Smith in Class 1 and Miss Goslitski in class 2. Mrs Hooker and Mrs Rolfe will be supporting the children in class.



## <u>Topic</u>

In the first half term our topic will be Memory Box. This focuses on the children's life experiences and memories. They will look at how we change and develop.

In the second half term our topic will be Splendid Skies. We will be investigating the weather and exploring outdoors.

#### <u>PE Kit</u>

PE lessons are on Wednesdays and Fridays

#### Home Learning

Home learning tasks will come home on a Friday and will need to be returned by Wednesday morning. Tasks will include reading and learning spellings, linked with our weekly phonics and grammar work. We will begin spellings in the next few weeks. Some weeks there will be English, Maths or Topic work. Homework will be put on e-schools explaining the tasks.

#### <u>Maths</u>

Please help your child with these areas at home: Saying a number that is 1 more/1 less than any given number;



Count at least 20 everyday objects; Count forwards and backwards in twos, fives and tens.

#### **Reading**

In year one guided reading takes place daily Monday - Thursday. Children will bring home Guided Reading books on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Please can books be sent back in on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday morning with the reading diary in the A5 zip wallet. Please make comments in the reading diary which you can share with your child. Children should be reading at home to an adult at least three times a week. Please note in the reading record if your child has read, be it to an adult or independently. Any volunteers who can come in and help with reading (individual or group) will be greatly appreciated.

On a Friday the children will bring home a 'tub book' of their book band colour. They choose these themselves so may end up with the same book more than once. They will also choose a 'free choice' library book to take home. Some books have stage numbers on the back of books. We do not use these numbers as levels so do not worry if the numbers differ from week to week.
