# **Topic**

# **Frozen Kingdom**

Frozen Kingdom is a geography-based topic focused on the Artic and Antarctic regions as well as the animals that live there. We link this topic to our writing through fantasy stories such as: The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe by CS Lewis and Sky Song by Abi Elphinstone.

#### **Fallen Fields**

Fallen Fields is a historic topic studying World War 1. This term we will be reading Private Peaceful by Michael Morpurgo. If your child has the book at home they are welcome to bring it in.

### PE Kit

### **Home Learning**

## <u>Maths</u>

### Focus of the term:

To read, write, order, compare and round numbers up to 10 000 000 and determine the value of each digit, including decimals.

To use negative numbers in context.

To be fluent in the mental recall of all times tables up to 12 x 12.

To add, subtract, multiply and divide multi-digit numbers (including decimals) using the formal written methods., including long division

# **Reading**

In class, we will be reading a range of texts , including Sky Song by Abi Elphinstone.

All children have a reading record book which they are expected to take home and bring into school daily. Teachers will check record books in your child's weekly guided reading session. Children may use school library books or bring in an age appropriate book from home. Please listen to your child read at least three times per week in order to help them increase their vocabulary and deepen their understanding of the text. If your child has lost or misplaced their reading record, please let us know as soon as possible.
