School Uniform

From September all the children must return to school in full school uniform.

- ♦ Skirts and trousers must be smart school wear.
- ♦ Smart black shoes should be worn, without flashing lights. Children are not allowed trainers, fashion shoes or boots.
- ♦ In Years 5 and 6 all children must wear a white shirt or a white blouse, with a school tie and in Years 3 and 4 children can wear a shirt and tie but this is optional.
- ♦ Children are not allowed to wear jewellery in school, including smart watches. Earrings are not allowed to be worn for safety reasons and children will be asked to remove them.
- ♦ Hair accessories must be in school colours, yellow or bottle green. Extreme hair cuts or hair gel/cream are not allowed. Hair longer than shoulder length must be tied back.
- ♦ Please remember **all** children need a coat, as they will be outside during the day.
- ♦ **PE KIT** All children need to wear a white t-shirt with bottle green shorts and a bottle green tracksuit in colder weather.

Please can you also make sure all items are named. We take a tremendous amount of unnamed items to charity as we are unable to return them to their rightful owners.
