

# **Enriching the Curriculum**

Developing your child's mathematical fluency

The development of mental fluency unpins much of the mathematics curriculum. Instant recall of facts including number bonds, doubles/halves and times tables helps enormously with mental agility. When children move onto written calculations and abstract methods, knowing these key facts is crucial. Recently, we have introduced 'KIRFS', 'Key Instant Recall Facts', to help our children learn the



key facts they need for future learning. Please see our website or ask your class teacher for more information about this. For children to become more efficient in recalling facts easily, they need to be practised frequently and in short bursts. The secret to success is practising little and often. Use time wisely: Can you practise whilst walking to school or during a car journey? Can you play games with playing cards or dice to practise addition, subtraction and multiplication facts? Board games such as Snakes and Ladders are also great ways of practising number recognition. There are lots of games online which practise these skills. Websites such as Topmarks, Mathsisfun and BBC Bitesize are useful and don't forget we also have subscriptions to Mathletics and Timestable Rockstars.

# **In Class Learning**

In computing, Year 2 have been learning about robot algorithms. This week they made their own algorithms and programmed robots to follow a set of instructions. Also in DT, they have been learning about vehicles. This week they were looking at different types of axles and wheels and explored the best materials to use to make these vehicles.


Please note that nail varnish is not allowed to be worn at school.
