# **Grange Paddocks Opening Big Splash Fun Day**

Each station will be led by an Olympic or Commonwealth athlete, an expert in the discipline, who will provide instruction and encourage the children.

As well as having the opportunity to meet successful Olympic athletes, experience the different sports, have a photograph taken and get an autograph, the event will conclude with a fun 'Race the Olympian' and each child will go home with a medal.

<u>Masks</u> In order to protect our whole school community, we would request that parents continue to wear masks while you are on school grounds. Thank you for your support.

<u>Positive Cases</u> At present, the government guidance is for children showing symptoms of Covid to be kept at home and to take a PCR test.

If your child tests positive for Covid they will need to self-isolate for a 10 day period in accordance with the current guidance. Currently, there is no longer a requirement for close contacts (aged 11 and under or those who are fully vaccinated) of a positive case to isolate for this period however updated guidance will be sent out should the situation arise.
