DSPL3: 'Power of Silence' Parent Workshop to be held at Northgate from 9.15am to 11.15am on Friday, 8th February

This free workshop is designed to help parents and carers understand the impact of language and communication. The session highlights the importance of communication between parents and children with additional needs and the facilitator will model the strategies and skills that are required. The session will cover elements of 'STEPS' with regards to limited language, positive phrasing and choice making, as well as ideas concerning processing time and how to extend communication exchanges with support. The workshop is open to all parents of children with additional needs, rather than just those with Autism.
