## Welcome to Year 4

### **Topic**

This term our topic is 'Potions'. The children will be creating their own stories based on the book of Alice in Wonderland. They will also be designing and creating a healthy potion (smoothie) in technology.

In the second half term, our topic will be 'Misty Mountains'. The children will be learning about different mountain ranges throughout the world and locating them on a map. They will also be using wool, ribbon and coloured threads in art to create contour weavings.

#### Maths

- Mental addition and subtraction
- Formal written methods of addition and subtraction

We would be grateful if you could support your child in learning their times tables at home. Year Four will be completing the new National Times tables test in the summer term.

#### Reading

In class, we will be reading a range of texts, including Alice in Wonderland which is linked to this term's topics.

All children have a reading record book which they are expected to take home and bring into school daily. Children may use school library books or bring in an age appropriate book from home. Please listen to your child read at least three times per week in order to help them increase their vocabulary and deepen their understanding of the text. If your child has lost or misplaced their reading record, please let us know as soon as possible.
