Science Week

During science week (week commencing Monday 8th July) children will be making bird feeders. If you have any of the items below, please could you donate them to the school office where there will be a collection box. To make homemade bird feeders we require any of the following: small plastic water bottles (e.g. 500ml), juice or milk cartons, Pringle pots (small or large), yoghurt pots, cardboard tubes such as: kitchen towel or wrapping paper (unfortunately, for hygiene regions, we are not able to accept toilet roll tubes), wooden implements e.g. spatulas or wooden spoons or any wooden dowelling and any netting from fruit and pine cones. *Please note that we have already taken precautionary measures for any children who have allergies. Children will also be pond dipping during the week. If you would like to help, please talk to your child's class teacher about their pond dipping slot.

Changes to School Meals Charges

Please note that school dinners will be going up from £2.50 to £2.60 a day from 1st September 2019.

If you wish your child to change their meal pattern, at any time, we do ask that you give one week's notice, as the kitchen need to order their food in advance.

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal, funded by the government, under the Universal Infant Free School Meals Grant.

If your child is moving from Year 2 to Year 3 and you would like to change their meal pattern from September, please can you e-mail the office on admin@northgate.herts.sch.uk and let us know on what days your child would like to have dinners and the date that they would like to make the change.

We offer the following meal patterns, with your child having school meals: Every day, Wednesdays and Fridays, Wednesdays only, Fridays only or no days.
