Headteacher's News

We hope that you found the 'Foundation Stage Meet the Teacher' sessions informative and that the Year 1 phonics session was useful. Next week there will be a multiplication workshop for year 3 and 4 parents. Year 4 will take part a national multiplication assessment at the start of next year. At Northgate, we value giving the children opportunities to be involved in many different roles across the school in order to help them learn a variety of skills, including responsibility and organisation. Key roles in Year 6 are the House and Vice Captains, who carry out different jobs throughout the year and across the school. To appoint the House Captains two methods were used. The staff voted based on who has consistently modelled the school code in terms of behaviour, attitude and work ethic. The children also wrote and delivered a short speech to the senior leadership team highlighting their attributes and experience to make them a successful House Captain. The leadership team were truly blown away with the children—they all delivered their speech with confidence, giving wonderful examples of how they had been an active member of the Northgate community and how they had developed their leadership and teamwork skills. It was a very close run competition with so many strong candidates. Winners can been seen with other leadership roles on the next page. Well done to everyone who took part!
