# **Reception Places**

The application process for places at primary schools for September 2022 opened on **Monday 1 November 2021.**This process is for children currently in nursery and who are turning 5 between 01/09/2022 and 31/08/2023. The admissions arrangements for the school year 2022-23 are available on the school website <a href="Determined Admission Arrangements">Determined Admission Arrangements</a>. #### **School Uniform Code**
