Enriching the Curriculum

In connection with their recent map work in Geography, both Year 3 classes took part in an exciting orienteering walk to Waitrose yesterday. Throughout the journey, the children worked collaboratively to plot significant local landmarks, carefully recording each stage of their route. They used photographs to support their observations and added detailed notes to their worksheets to help build an accurate record of their trail. The walk offered the pupils a valuable opportunity to apply their classroom learning to a real-life setting, strengthening their understanding of direction, symbols, and map features.

Safeguarding

If your child is unwell and not attending school, parents must leave a message with the school **each morning before 9.00am** either by phone or emailing Absence@northgate.herts.sch.uk We have a duty of care to ensure all children are accounted for as soon as possible each day.

The kitchen has also requested that parents remember to <u>cancel their child's lunch</u> if they are not coming in. Please do this before 8.00am to avoid charges and unnecessary food waste. Thank you.

Medicines: If your child requires medicine during the school day, a 'Administration of Medication' form must be completed. You will find the form on our school website or here. An adult must hand the medication in/collected to/from the school office. Children must not bring medicines to school in their bags or pockets. The medication must be in its original packaging, with leaflets, in date and, where relevant, have the pharmacy label attached. It is vital that parents keep aware of expiry dates and replace items such as inhalers and auto-injectors prior to expiry.
