Enriching the curriculum

Both Reception classes went on their first local walk this week - they all had lots of fun walking to the cricket field, looking at signs of autumn and collecting acorns. They played some circle games before walking back to school along the tree shadow line.







Year 1 have been learning about their senses. Last Friday they became 'Popcorn Investigators'. They investigated how to make popcorn and used their senses (taste, touch, sight, hearing, smell) to describe it!



On Wednesday, Year 2 enjoyed a walk to the site of Waytemore Castle in Bishop's Stortford as part of their Towers, Turrets and Tunnels topic. They enjoyed looking at the site of the old motte-and-bailey castle. They discussed its history, imagined what it would have looked like, measured out its walls and then drew detailed sketches of the mound. The children behaved exceptionally well and we were very proud of them.





Ten children from across Years 3 and 4 played their first dodgeball tournament on Monday. They played against Howe Green and Thorn Grove. All children had a chance to play in a match and they thoroughly enjoyed taking part in this fixture.

On Thursday Class 7 and Friday Class 8 children attended a pizza masterclass at the Bishops Stortford Franco Manca restaurant. During this experience, the children were able to make and eat the pizza for lunch that they designed in class as part of their Design and Technology unit. The Franco Manca trip was incredible. The children all thoroughly enjoyed their time in the masterclass. They were all able to knead their own dough and pick toppings for their pizza.
