Headteacher's News

Happy New Year! I hope you had a magical Christmas and a positive start to the New Year. We look forward to seeing you throughout the term.

Please note that holidays taken during term time are not normally authorised, and the school is required to share information about unauthorised absences with Hertfordshire County Council, who may issue fixed penalty notices. Children who arrive after 9.30am, unless they have a medical appointment, will be marked as unauthorised for that session.
