The Life Bus

The children have really enjoyed the Life Bus visiting Northgate this week. Each year group had a different programme and these were:

- Nursery:Taking Care of Myself focusing on how the body gets
energy and the importance of personal hygiene.Reception:All About Me focusing on how the body gets energy,
medicines and dealing with sadness.
- Year 1: **My Wonderful Body** focusing on a healthy diet and how a person's behaviour can hurt others' feelings.
- Year 2: Feelings focusing on recognising, naming and understanding how to deal with feelings.
- Year 3: Meet the Brain focusing on qualities of friendship, reasons why friends fall out and skills for making up.
- Year 4: It's Great to be Me focusing on understanding that everyone is unique and understanding the key risks and effects of smoking and drinking alcohol.
- Year 5: **Friends** focusing on recognising and understanding basic emotional needs, Identifying characteristics of behavior and rehearsing assertiveness skills.
- Year 6: **Decisions** focusing on identifying risk factors involving alcohol and recognising and empathising with patterns of behaviour in peer-group dynamics.



Please encourage your children to talk to you about what they have learnt on the Life Bus this week. This is an important part of our health and well-being work.
