## Safeguarding: Important Safety Reminder: Children Cycling

Children must **not ride their bikes** through the staff car park. This area is extremely busy and poses a potential safety risk to both cyclists and drivers. Please talk to your child about this to keep them safe.

## Important Information – Sun Creams and Lip Balms

For the safety of all our pupils, please check the ingredients of any sun creams and lip balms for nut oils or nut-based products. Some children at Northgate have severe nut allergies, and certain ingredients—such as Prunus amygdalus dulcis (sweet almond oil)—can be found in sun protection products. Please note:

- Sun cream should not be brought into school by your child. Apply sun cream generously at home in the morning to ensure your child is protected throughout the school day.
- If your child requires a top-up during the day, a medication form must be completed (available on our website), and the sun cream must be handed in to the school office.
- Lip balms are also classed as medication and should be handed in to the office along with a completed form.
