Safeguarding

- Letting us know about any change in legal or safeguarding circumstances — e.g. court orders, custody arrangements, or any situation that may affect who collects your child. Please call or email the office on admin@northgate.herts.sch.uk
- Talking to your children about keeping themselves safe - including online safety, healthy relationships and what to do if they feel worried or unsafe. There is lots of advice on the NSPCC website.

Enriching the Curriculum


In relation to their topic *Land Ahoy!*, the children in Year 2 have been busy making lighthouses in Design and Technology this week. Working independently, they selected their own materials and used a range of skills such as measuring, cutting, combining and joining using glue, masking tape and other resources. They showed great creativity and resilience as they designed and assembled their very own lighthouse models. As part of the topic, the children are also learning about famous pirates. They have enjoyed exploring the lives of well-known historical figures, discovering fascinating facts and using these to inspire their wider learning.
