Headteacher's News

Welcome back to a new school year and a warm welcome to all our new families. I hope that you had an enjoyable summer. We have had a great first week back, in the heat, with a whole school arts week with work based on the Lowry picture 'Britain at Play.'

I am at the main gate most mornings so please catch me or pop into the office if you would like to make an appointment. If it is a class issue, please make sure you have raised the issue with the teacher first. If you would like an appointment with your child's class teacher, please write a note to them, use the class email address or arrange it at the end of the day with their teacher. We do not allow adults around the back of the school in the mornings for safeguarding reasons. Adults who need to come into school must sign in at the office. If you are not happy with response from the class teacher, our middle leaders this year are Mrs McFarlane, Mr Sainsbury, Mrs Shepherd and Mr Brown. They would be very happy to meet you to discuss a problem.

Safeguarding in schools is paramount and all adults volunteering will need annual updates. The next session for volunteers will be on Tuesday 19th September. If you do help in school, I would be grateful if you could ensure that you attend this session. If you are interested in helping in class please contact the office or your class teacher. Thank you. I look forward to seeing all students develop and make good progress this year.

Parental Involvement

We value your support and involvement in the school and there are a number of ways for you to become involved:

One-to-One Reading

We are looking for parents who would like to help with reading in KS1 one day a week or more from 9.00am to 9.20am (Mon-Thurs), or in the afternoons. Having an adult read with children, makes a huge difference to the children's learning. Reading will start on Monday 18th September. If you would like to help this year, whether you have helped before or not, please complete an on-line form to let us know when you are available, you can find this on our website.

<u>Safeguarding sessions will be held at 9.00am on Monday 18th September</u> and will include a supporting reading training session.

Safeguarding

Safeguarding Leads

If you have a safeguarding issue, this year our designated safeguarding leads are Mrs Tanner, Mrs Clynes, Mrs Layer and Mrs Wallace.

Medicines

If your child needs any medicine, please be advised that it must be in its original packaging, with leaflets, in date and, where relevant, have the pharmacy label attached. <u>Children must not bring</u> <u>medicines to school in their bags or pockets.</u> They need to be brought in by an adult and handed in/collected to/from the school office. An 'Administration of Medication' form must be completed before dropping off. Forms can be found on the school website under Parent Information, Medical. Parents need to be aware of expiry dates and replace items such as inhalers and auto-injectors prior to expiry.

Reminders and Updates

Uniform Reminders

It was great to see all the children looking so smart at the start of term. Just to remind you **all items must be named.**

Skirts and trousers must be smart school wear. The Upper Key Stage 2 children are expected to wear a <u>shirt and tie</u>. Ties are optional in Lower Key Stage 2.

Smart black shoes should be worn, without flashing lights (or with the lights turned off). Children are **not** allowed to wear trainers, fashion shoes or boots.

Children are **not** allowed to wear earrings or other jewellery in school. Children who have not had their <u>earrings</u> removed after the summer need to have a letter explaining the situation addressed to Mrs Tanner. <u>Smart watches</u> must not be worn in school. Hair accessories must be in school colours, yellow or bottle green. No extreme Hairstyles allowed. Thank you for your support.

During PE lessons <u>all children</u> should wear bottle green shorts with and a white t-shirt (with school logo or unbranded white t-shirt) and a bottle green tracksuit. No extreme Hairstyles allowed.

Second Hand Uniform

We have a lot of second hand uniform in very good condition. This will be on sale in the main reception area for the next couple of weeks and then on Fridays only. Please come and have a look. Payment by cash only.

Water bottles

Please could you make sure your children's water bottles measure no more than 15cm in height (with the top off) as taller bottles do not fit in the machine and this is causing regular flooding of the dining room floor. Thank you

School Lunches

Please continue to pre-order lunches on School Grid as usual. For children in Years 3 to 6, payment for lunches will continue to be made on School Gateway. The cost of lunch is still £3.20, please ensure that your child's a account is in credit at all times, thank you. Parking

Please remember to show consideration to others when driving and parking near the school.

Mobile Phones

Children are not permitted to bring mobile phones into school. A year 6 child may have permission from their parent to walk home alone (please fill out a permission slip on our website stating this). In this instance the phone should be handed to their class teacher as they come into registration and will be given back to them at the end of the day.

Pupil Premium Grant

If you are struggling financially and think you may need help, then please consider checking your eligibility for free school meals by visiting <u>www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals</u>. If your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2, and therefore entitled to a free school lunch as part of the Universal Free School Meal programme, registration will help schools to identify anyone on low income and will enable the school to claim funding towards additional staff time, support financially with school trips, extra computers, books, trips, etc. If you have any questions or would like help with an application, please email Mrs Padgett in the school office at pupil premium@northgate.herts.sch.uk.
