Welcome back to Mr Wilcox who is teaching in Year 3 for 2 terms. Welcome to Miss Newman and Mr George who are working in Year 1 and 2 for the next 2 terms.

We are delighted to have started the school term with just a handful of positive cases among the children. However, for the first 2 days we had 20% of our class teachers off.
