Music

This week we have applied to take part in the Hertfordshire Schools' Gala Concert at the Royal Albert Hall on Sunday 8th March. Many thanks to the members of orchestra for their contribution to last week's music assembly on the theme of enjoying musical opportunities, in which they talked about the benefits and challenges of learning an instrument, and to Thomas Waltham and Dylan Sanders for their solo performances at the start and end of assembly. A musical highlight of this week was a joint rehearsal in which Class 12 supported Reception children in preparation for a shared performance of 'Happy' to help us all feel good during Wellbeing Week after half term. It was lovely to see the oldest and youngest members of the school learning together and from each other so effectively.
