Headteacher's News

I hope you had a lovely Easter holiday and managed to enjoy the great weather.

Congratulations to all of our football teams who have been competing at Howe Green School this week in the K.A.S. Football Festival. Northgate have had a hugely successful season - well done to every player involved and to all the parents for their support throughout the season.

We have a busy summer term ahead, with many special events and themed days organised. We are planning Jubilee celebrations at the end of this half term. Your child's termly letter will contain more details regarding dates and key information about the term.

This week we introduced 'inclusiveness' as our assembly value for this half term and reflected on what this means. We also introduced the new learning power - Independent Enquirer Elephant which includes identifying questions to answer and problems to solve, setting up your own investigations, using your initiative and exploring issues.

This term we have the return to the <u>National Assessments</u> for Year 1, Year 2, Year 4 and Year 6 pupils. <u>Please do not book holiday during these weeks</u> as the participation of all children in school is incredibly important in order to accurately target their learning.

Year 1 - Phonics screening check week will take place during the week commencing **Tuesday 7th June** and children will complete this 1-to-1 with their class teacher.

Year 2 - SATs will take place throughout May 2022. These assessments are taken in small groups across the month of May. They are called 'quizzes' by the teachers and are kept as low key and non-stressful as possible for the children. Additionally, pupils who did not meet the expected standard in the autumn 2021 assessments in phonics will re-take this check during the week commencing Tuesday 7th June.

Year 4 - The multiplication tables check is statutory for all year 4 pupils and will take place in small groups from the **7th to 24th June**

Year 6 - SATs will take place between **Monday 9th** and **Thursday 12th May** and are more formal with the children completing them in exam conditions.

Other year groups will be completing assessments towards the end of May. Please may sure that your child makes the best of this key learning time by arriving at school on time and ensuring he/she does not miss school unless absolutely necessary. We greatly appreciate your support with this.

Ukrainian Families in Bishop's Stortford

All children and young people arriving in England from Ukraine via the family or sponsorship routes have the right to access education and childcare (for children below compulsory school age) whilst in the UK.

The best place for all school-age children to be educated is in schools, and attending school is vital to help newly arrived children integrate as quickly as possible into the communities in which they are living.

Any families returning to or moving to the UK should speak to the local authority <u>school admission team</u> for information on how to apply for a school place. Local authorities should support parents in choosing schools, which includes providing information on where schools have vacancies and how to apply. UK based school age rules will apply to families arriving from Ukraine too.

Safeguarding

As we start the new term, please can we remind <u>all</u> parents and carers to park safely and considerately outside school and within neighbouring roads during school pickup and drop off times.

<u>Please ensure that the school car park gates are not blocked</u> <u>at any time</u> as this is the only access point for emergency vehicles

School Meal Increase and Changes to Menu

Hertfordshire Catering have increased the cost of school dinners to £2.88 per day from Tuesday 19th April. This applies to children in Key Stage 2 (Year 3 to 6). Children in Reception and Key Stage 1 are still eligible for free school meals under the Universal Infant Free School Meals scheme.

Please can you make payment on School Gateway in advance of your child taking any meals. You can pay in advance monthly or weekly, but please ensure that you are always in credit for your child's meals.

If your family has a low income, you may be eligible for financial assistance while your children are at school.


